

Display who has access to security keys

In System Administration go to Reports > Group or User Security then use Security Keys commands and use the Name option.


This will give you a wide variety of commands and they work right to left (the right most starting with the module and then the path).

this example will return groups/ users that have access to:

Registrar > Maintenance > Faculty/Staff> Address

Or

Registrar > View> Faculty/Staff:
