Restore points in Scheduler

The scheduling module itself is a Sandbox that you can use to, create A schedule to be used for the following school year. You are able to make a multitude of changes to what was your existing School Schedule. Updates to Calendar, periods and classes.

- Restore points allow you to set "save" points for work you have done up until a specific point (in case of errors, conflicts or wholesale changes).
- One of the first things that it is recommended to be done once the Scheduler has been rolled to set up for the Academic year is to create a Restore point
- Restore points do not prevent mistakes, scheduling conflict and or Restore data not already present in the Scheduling module. They are simply fixed points I time that save your work.

To create a Restore point in the Scheduling module:

Maintenance > Initialization > Clean up / Reinitialize > Scheduling Restore Points
